COVID19 Protocols – Recommended by Western Canadian Certified Hoof Trimmers Association and recognizing the Western Canadian Farriers Association for their input.

- If you are sick **STAY HOME**.
- Check with clients about recent travel/and or sickness. **CANCEL** or **RESCHEDULE** your appointments as necessary.
- Request farmers, herdsman and farm hand reduce human traffic in the area you are working in.
- Request, if possible, to work in the hoof trimming area without anyone around.
- Practice **SOCIAL DISTANCING** (2 meter apart) if necessary to work around others.
- Request no coffee/food is brought to you while are working.
- **WASH HANDS** with soap upon arrival at the barn.
- **WASH HANDS** with soap upon leaving the barn.
- **SANITIZE TOOLS** and **EQUIPMENT** between barns.
- Limit touching things to only what is necessary.
- Wear gloves while opening/close gates, barn doors, etc.
- Request payment methods like eTransfer or Cheques. Avoid cash payments.
